VI TOXICITY DATA

Primary Route of (Entry) Exposure:

Inhalation: Dusts may cause irritation to nose and upper respiratory tract; highly unlikely because of package form.

Eyes: Dusts or powder may cause irritation; highly unlikely because of package form.

Skin: Powder may cause irritation with prolonged and repeated contact; highly unlikely because of package form.

Ingestion: May cause nausea, vomiting, cramps and diarrhea.

VII FIRST AID

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air.

Eyes: Immediately flush with cool water. Remove contact lenses; continue flushing for 15 minutes, holding eyelids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire eye. Contact a physician.

Skin: Rinse affected area with water. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

Ingestion: **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** If victim is conscious, rinse mouth and give 1-2 glasses of water or milk. Consult a physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

VIII PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

Gloves: Wear rubber or plastic gloves when handling pouches covered in powder.

Eye Protection: Wear safety glasses.

Other Protective Equipment: None normally required.

Engineering Controls:

Local Exhaust: Not required.

Leak and Spill

Procedures: Pick up undamaged pouches and place in labelled air tight containers. Sweep up any damaged pouches and spilled powder and place in suitable containers for disposal. Flush any powder residue away with water. Do not allow any rinse water to enter open bodies of water or storm sewers. Review Federal, Provincial and Local government regulations for disposal.

Handling Procedures and Equipment:

Do not open pouches to mix product: pouches dissolve in water. Do not handle pouches with wet hands. Do not mix with anything but water. Wash hands thoroughly after handling pouches.

Storage

Requirements: **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Keep containers closed. Store at room temperature. Keep from freezing (freezing makes pouches brittle).
